

DAY 1 ARRIVE HALIFAX

DAY 2 PEGGY'S COVE & LUNENBURG

Pass seaside hamlets and harbor towns en route to Peggy's Cove for time to explore as you wish. Continue to Lunenburg for lunch and a choice of afternoon excursions. Explore the town on a walking tour; its 19th-century wooden homes are a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Or visit the Fisheries Museum of the Atlantic, focused on the seafaring heritage of the Canadian Maritime provinces. Return to Halifax for an evening at leisure.

DAY 3 HISTORIC HALIFAX & A CITADEL EVENING

WEDNESDAY, OCTOBER 1

DAY 5 P.E.I. NATIONAL PARK & GREEN GABLES

Following a morning at leisure in Charlottetown, set out to explore the wildlife-rich salt marshes and dramatic coastal bluffs of Prince Edward Island National Park. Next, learn about a staple of the PEI economy, Prince Edward Island oysters, on a visit to Raspberry Point Oyster Company. Discover the world of oyster farming, from growth to shucking, and enjoy an opportunity to taste the freshest oysters right out of the ocean and learn about their distinctive flavors.

Next, tour the "Anne of Green Gables" National Historic Site, made famous in Lucy Maud Montgomery's beloved book. Learn about the landscapes that inspired her and play a large role in her books. We'll end the day with a traditional lobster dinner – a must-have experience on PEI!
